

## Review: Where to find O.C.'s Top 10 steaks

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I've written previously about the nearly 2-foot-long, 58-ounce tomahawk ribeye at The Ranch in Anaheim, and I still rank that behemoth among the area's best. In the absence of the late Diamond Jim Brady, or the fictional Mr. Creosote in Monty Python's "The Meaning of Life" — you know, the guy who eats so much he explodes — this steak is rather meant for two people to share. For such a gigantic steak, it is remarkably tender and sophisticated. And there are other stratospherically priced Flintstones-style steaks to enjoy, like the off-menu Delmonico at Arc, the Lord Stanley cut at Selanne and the carved-tableside T-bone at Andrea, all of which hover around \$100.

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
